



## Directions to O2 Concert Venue from Abraham House

Abraham House is the perfect base for going to concerts in the O2 Venue, as you can walk easily from the hostel to the O2, and we are still in the city centre for other sightseeing or socialising you would like to do.

### Walking to the O2 from Abraham House: 20 Minutes

Turn left outside the door, walk down to the end of Gardiner Street. The back of the beautiful Custom House building is in front of you, across the Luas (tram) lines.

Keep left and walk towards the modern buildings of the IFSC, to the front and the right. You will see a bridge and the River Liffey. Walk around the IFSC buildings and keep left, walking along the River Liffey, which is to your right.

Keep walking along the river for 10-15 minutes and you will see the O2 venue on your left hand side.

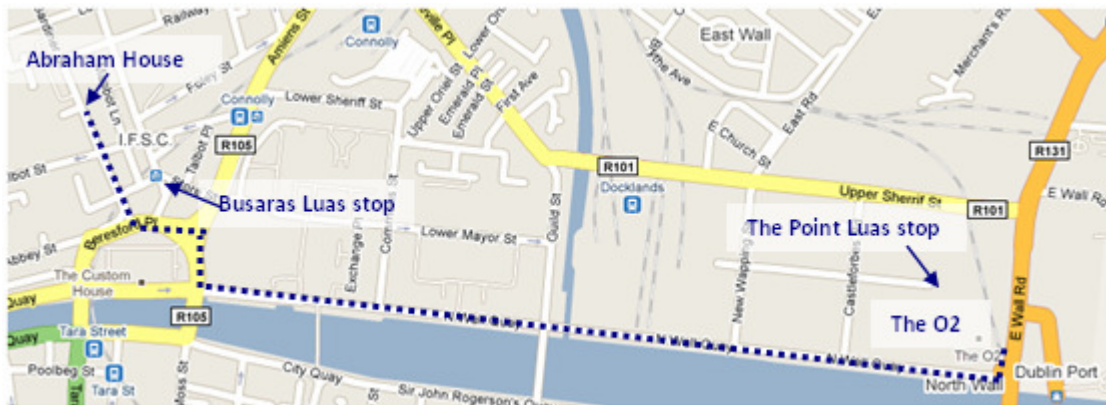


Along the way, you will pass some interesting sights as you walk through the Dublin Docklands, including the bleak Famine Memorial sculpture, the Jeanie Johnson tall ship (when she is docked in Dublin) and the cool CHQ building.

### Tram (Luas) to the O2 from Abraham House: 10 Minutes

Turn left outside the door, walk down towards the Custom House. Take the second left just before the overhead railway bridge. Walk to the end of this short alley and Busaras Luas stop is in front of you. Take the Luas tram with destination "The Point", which is the former name of the O2 venue.

The Luas journey time from Busaras to the Point is 7 minutes and costs €2.90 for a return ticket, which may be purchased from the ticket vending machines at each Luas stop.
